## Be Green

Following the recent 2<sup>nd</sup> Green Britain Day on 17<sup>th</sup> June Your Parish Council aims to promote as many green initiatives as possible.

For instance, Did you know you can borrow an energy monitor from the library in the same way you can borrow a book or a CD? The monitors are free to loan and can show you how much electricity you are using. The monitor updates your electricity usage every 6 seconds, allowing you to switch appliances on and off and learn how much energy each appliance uses. The monitor is very simple to operate and takes about five minutes to set up

Once you know how much things cost, you can start working out the best ways to make savings.
