## A MONTHLY ROUND UP OF NEWS & EVENTS

### WORKING TO REDUCE CRIME & ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

During June, your Neighbourhood Policing Team have been working to reduce antisocial behaviour. We have been doing this with a combined effort. We have been visiting, and will continue to visit our open spaces and park areas, engaging with our residents, whilst offering reassurance through visibility.

We have also been working with our primary schools, and since September 2024 to June 2025, we have given 64 (75-minute) presentations, and held vast discussions with 1,715 Year 6 children. During the presentations, focused on reducing crime and antisocial behaviour, we explored harassment, alarm, and distress, and how these feelings manifest. The children gave positive feedback and 97% said they benefitted or gained from the presentations, 97% said they now have a greater understanding of antisocial behaviour, 91% said the presentation will change how they think and behave and 92% said it will impact how they treat other people. Thank you once again to all our young people involved, for your positive behaviours and the engagement that you had with us, for listening and sharing your views, and working together to make our neighbourhood's better places.

## DISTRICT STATISTICS

### District Statistics for Rochford – May 2025

### A snapshot of some of the things your Rochford Officers dealt with during May 2025:

We helped to find 12 people who were reported missing and helped them to get the support they needed.

We investigated 29 reports of antisocial behaviour having listened to local communities about the things which were causing them concern.

We attended 16 road traffic collisions, helping to keep those involved safe and our roads moving.

We investigated 99 reports of domestic violence incidents and made sure victims were given help, support, and advice, putting them in contact with relevant organisations where appropriate.

We solved 77 crimes, ensuring those intent on committing crime are held accountable for their actions.

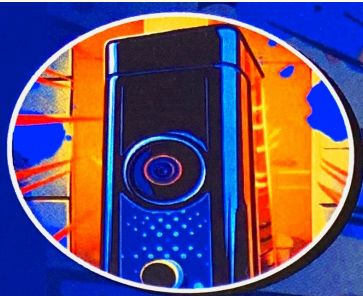
We submitted 188 pieces of intelligence, which assists us in targeting criminal activity in our community.

Our officers also stopped and searched 28 people within our district, to make sure they weren't carrying anything which could cause harm to themselves or someone else.

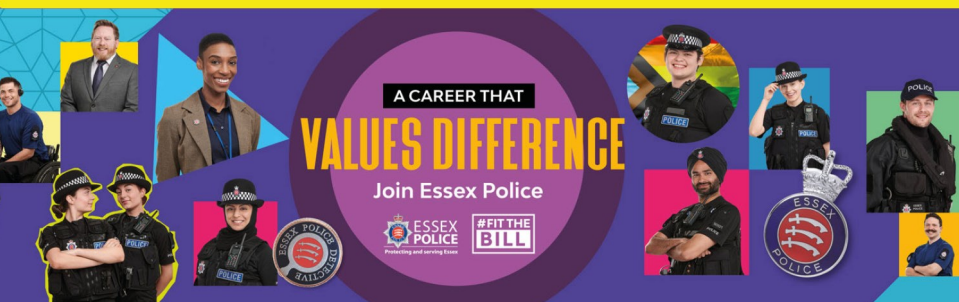
